the date of marriage.

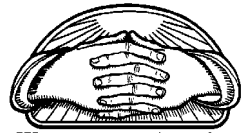
ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Done after any

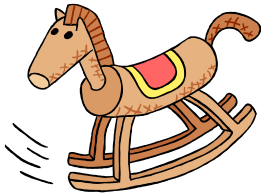

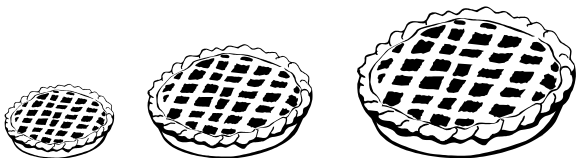
