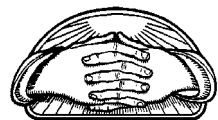

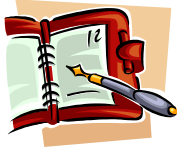
YOUTH DANCE: St. Clement/Cathedral
