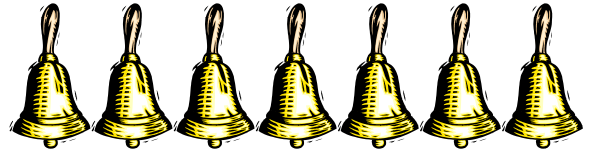
REMINDER
