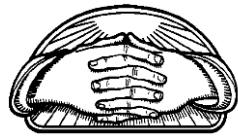

**EAT OUT & HELP SUPPORT OUR**

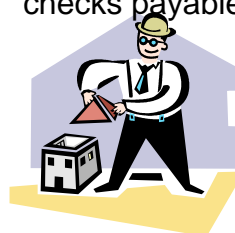

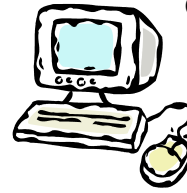
