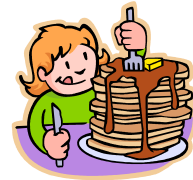

Meals are \$6 for Adults & \$4.00 for children under 12. Italian cookies will also be on sale. All are welcome!



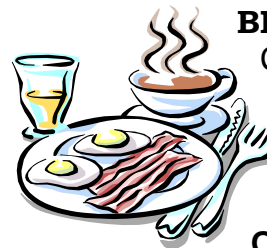
