the date of marriage.**

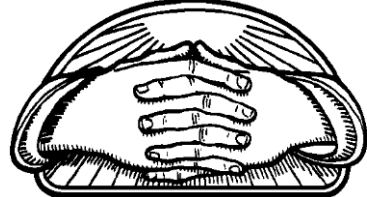

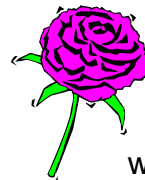
