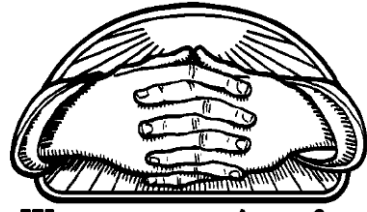

NEWS: The arrival of June means preparation for Graduation at the LALC. Our ceremony was held on June 3rd at 10:00am for our 4 year old class. We are finalizing plans for our Summer Program for school age children. Flyers were in the bulletin and sent home through our Catholic school students. We have been busy refurbishing our last remaining classroom for use by the summer program. A new air conditioning unit will be purchased. These upgrades will benefit the summer program & our CCD/Ministries program. LALC has been able to repair broken glass in the school building windows and is continuing to contribute to the payment of the Parish's utility bills. Our staff is continuing to receive development classes in the areas of Environmental Rating Scale, Diversity, Fire Safety & Training and Positive Discipline.
