**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** Done after any Sunday Mass when requested.

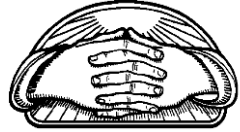

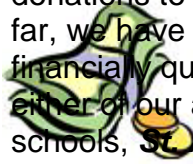
