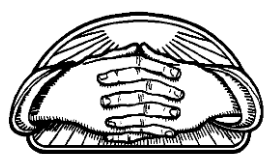

Saturday, August 13th, from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Come and browse our huge selection!



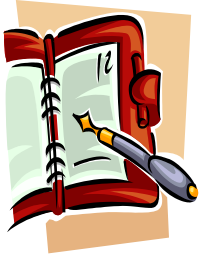
