can be dropped off in the vestibule of the Church and we will arrange pick up of the items. Thank you!

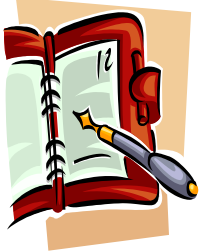
### **FIRST ANNUAL CRAFTIN' & CRUISIN'**
