LITURGY: Bishop Mark Barchak and the Family

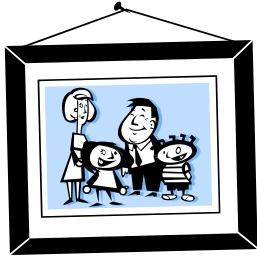
