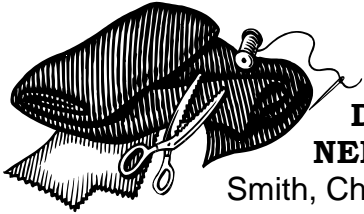


## VISITATION CHOIR—FIRST PRACTICE—NEW MEMBERS

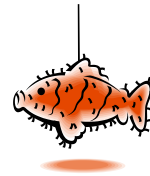
