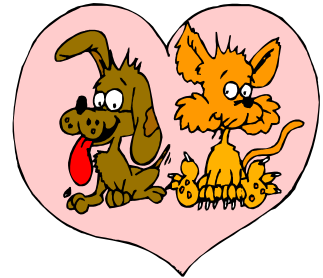
REMINDER: The 11th Grade Confirmation Class meets from 6:00-7:00 PM Sunday evenings. Both Public & Bishop McCort students must attend.

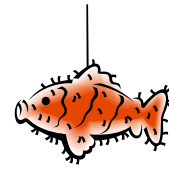
