Retreat begins with the 8:00 AM Mass and will conclude at 11:00 AM. Both Bishop McCort & Parish Religious Education students are to attend.

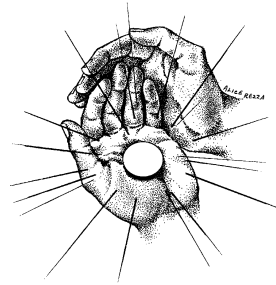
REFLECTION—MARRIAGE
