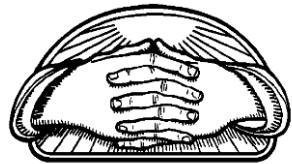
**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:** By appointment with the Pastor at least nine months prior to the date of marriage.

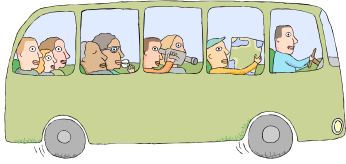


## LITTLE ANGEL LEARNING CENTER— DONATION NEEDED:
