**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:** By appointment with the Pastor at least nine months prior to the date of marriage.

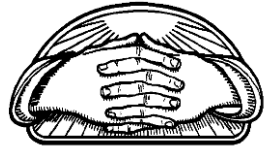
**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** Done after any Sunday Mass when requested.
