

DEADLY WATERS.

APPALING DISASTER TO THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN.

Eight Thousand Lives Lost in the Flood—Several Hundred Perish in the Flames.

(SPECIAL DISPATCHES TO THE RECORD-UNION.)

PITTSBURG, June 1st.—In this city to-day there was but one topic of conversation, and that was the Johnstown deluge. Crowds of eager watchers all day long besieged the newspaper bulletin-boards, and rendered the streets impassable. Many of them had their eyes fixed on the striking "Names" names which were their city. But there were no names. The storm which had been predicted for the lives of their loved ones had also carried away all means of communication, and their vigil was unavailing.

To show the state to which the telegraph is reduced it is sufficient to state that it is not known whether the operator at Johnstown is dead or alive.

ORDERS FOR COFFINS. The nearest point to that city which can be reached to-night is New Florence, and one who there is used most constantly by orders for coffins, embalming fluid, and preparing special cars to carry the recovered dead to their homes. Along the banks of the now turbulent Allegheny were placed watchers for dead bodies, and all wreckage was carefully scanned for dead.

THE DEATH OF THE VICTIMS. The result of this deluge was the recovery of one body, that of a woman. Seven other bodies have been seen, but could not be reached, and in a few cases moving wreckage by which they were surrounded. Measures for relief were promptly taken. The Mayor has issued orders for Allegheny issued calls for mass meetings, which were responded to by throngs of Pittsburgh's wealthiest men, and at 7 P. M. \$50,000 was in the committee's hands, and at 5 the sum was swelled to \$100,000.

NEW FLORENCE, June 1st.—Sang Hollow is the nearest point to which can be reached this morning. It is impossible to secure any definite information, but there seems to be no doubt that Johnstown is inundated, and that fully 10,000 were lost there.

The water is now receding, here as rapidly as it is rising there, and the bodies of the dead are showing up. Already nine dead bodies, among them five women, have been picked up, and three children. This brought since daylight. None as yet have been recognized.

MOTHER AND INFANT. One beautiful woman of 25 years old, had clasped in her arms a babe six months old.

The dead body of a young man was discovered in the wreckage of a tree which had been carried down stream.

All the orchard crops and shrubbery along the banks of the river were destroyed. The body of another woman has just been discovered in the river here. Her feet were found protruding from a log. A rope was fastened about it, and it is now to be a true assistance to land the body.

RESCUED FROM THE ROOF. John L. Webber and wife, an old couple, were rescued near here this morning by Mike Metzger and John Forney. They had been carried from the roof of a Cannery City on the roof of their house.

Seven others were on the roof of the Cannery City, and were rescued by the same party. They are unknown to Webber, they having drifted on to the roof from another building. Webber and wife were thoroughly drenched, and almost helpless from exposure. They were unable to walk when taken from the roof, and women, where the tide carried them.

Country people are coming in large numbers, telling stories of disaster along the river banks.

STREWS WITH DEAD. NEW FLORENCE (Pa.), June 1st.—John Metzger, a man of 40, was rescued from the roof of a building at 4 o'clock. He left Johnstown at 4:30 yesterday, and says the scene was horrible.

The people had been warned early in the morning to move to the highlands, but did not heed the warning, although repeated a hundred times. The water poured into Cider street several feet deep.

Then the houses began rocking and to and fro, and finally the force of the current carried buildings across the streets into vacant lots, and dashed them to pieces, each other, breaking them into fragments.

They LAUGHED AT DANGER. These buildings were freighted with poor wretches who so shortly before laughed at the cry of danger.

McCartney says in some cases he counted fifteen persons clinging to buildings.

It was impossible to get into Johnstown proper to-day in any manner except by rowboat, and the only hope is to get within thirty or forty miles of Johnstown, and then to get on by handcar. This will be done by an Associated Press agent within the next hour.

HORRIFYING DISCOVERIES. The banks on both sides of the river are crowded with anxious watchers, and with horrifying frequency they are rewarded by the discovery of a dead body.

Within the last half hour three floating bodies have been recovered at this point. Hundreds of people on the highlands and upriver towns are hurrying here in search of friends and relatives who were swept away in last night's deluge.

Intense excitement prevails. The street corners are crowded with pale and anxious people, who tell of the awful calamity with stifled breath.

PREPARATIONS FOR BURIAL. Bodies are being prepared for burial, but will be held for identification.

Four boys have just come from the river bank above here. They say that on the opposite side a number of bodies can be seen lying in the mud. They found the body of a woman on this side.

R. B. Rogers, a Justice of the Peace at Ninewa, stated that he found the body of a man at that place. From this one can estimate that 100 dead bodies were found at that place. From this one can estimate that 100 dead bodies will reach over 1,000—perhaps more.

No one knows, no one can guess the sickening sight that is expected to be met by the correspondents when they arrive at the scene.

A report has just been received that the bodies of a man and woman are on a partly submerged tree.

NEW FLORENCE (Pa.) June 1st.—Report has just reached here that at least 100 people were consumed in the flames at Johnstown last night. It is said to have been an awful horror, but definite information cannot be obtained here. The air is filled with thrilling and almost incredible stories, but none of them can be confirmed.

The fire was the culmination of the horror. The fire will fully reach 100, and they died in the midst of the flames.

The first authentic news comes from W. N. Hays of the Pennsylvania Company, who reached New York at 10 o'clock.

Ruins of houses, outbuildings and other structures were swept across the railroad bridge at Johnstown, and an overturning stove or some such cause, the upper part of the wreckage caught fire.

HORRORS OF FIRE AND FLOOD. There were crowds of men, women and children about the scene, and a large number added to the awful chorus of horrors. They were literally scorched in the flood.

Soon after the fire burned itself out others were thrown against the mass.

There were fifty people clinging to them when the mass broke up, and were swept under the bridge into the pitchy darkness.

The latest news from Johnstown is that two houses could be seen in town. It is also said that only three houses remain in Cambria City.

A HORRIBLE HOLOCAUST.
