## Sweepstakes Rules

1. All sweepstakes tickets are \$100.00. All additional meal tickets are \$25.00.
2. All unsold tickets and prizes offered on unsold tickets shall remain in the ownership of the Roxbury Bandshell Preservation Alliance.
3. Prizes are awarded based upon the order of the draw. The stub of each ticket sold will be placed inside an unmarked envelope and placed in a drawing barrel. Envelopes will be drawn one-at-a-time. A drawing schedule is listed in this program To help you follow the progress of the sweepstakes.
4. Tickets which remain unsold are disqualified from the drawing as indicated in the example below:  
**EXAMPLE:** If there are 20 unsold tickets, the drawing will proceed As follows: The first ticket actually drawn is assigned position #1 and wins (see 5a below) . Because there are 20 unsold tickets, the next 20 drawing positions (20 thru 21) are disqualified. The drawing resumes with the second ticket actually drawn being assigned position 22, the third assigned 23, the fourth assigned 24, etc.
5. PRIZES
  - A. Tickets drawn in positions 1,25,50,75,100,125,150,175, 200 and 225 will have the Choice of : \$100.00 CASH or refusing the \$100.00 cash prize and opting to have Their ticket reentered into the drawing.
  1. The ticket holders in 5a must report their decision to the ticket judge within 15 sec.
  2. If the cash prize winner decides to reenter his (her) ticket into the drawing, the next number drawn will be recorded on the drawing schedule under the "X".

9. We ask your cooperation and understanding with the timeliness of the drawing. The drawing will not be delayed if a person is not in the room when their ticket is awarded.

### Final Five Rules

After the 24<sup>5</sup>th ticket is drawn, only five tickets will remain. The owners of those five tickets will be invited to the front table for the FINAL FIVE CONFERENCE.

At the front table each finalist must decide to either:

1. Continue the drawing until they win OR
